
Discussion Notes - Parking

The type and amount of parking varies with each co-op. Choose the option that best suits your co-op.

There are several strategies your co-op may consider fair for assigning parking, such as:

- setting a maximum number of stalls per household
- using a rotation system
- assigning spots on a first-come, first-served basis and
- reducing number of stalls per member to accommodate members who obtain a first car.

These strategies are not included in the policy template options. If your co-op uses one or more of them, make sure they are clearly outlined in your co-op's parking policy or procedures.

Member needs are referred to in Point #4 and Point #11 of the sample policy and would include accessibility or medical considerations.
